



Committees and Purpose (Established 1999 unless otherwise noted)

Awards Committee (established 2000)

Chooses recipients of the Division awards (most distinguished scholar and most distinguished new scholar) and nominates recipients for ASC awards. This committee consists of nine members—1 chair, 3 at large members, 3 executive counselors, and 2 newer scholars.

Newsletter Committee

Disseminates news about the division and its concerns, both through a paper newsletter published each fall before ASC and on the web. This committee consists of 3 members appointed by the Division Chair who serve two year terms. The chair of the committee serves as editor and produces the newsletter.

Nominating Committee

Recruits candidates for upcoming elections

Outreach Committee

Works for the division in its contacts with the ASC membership and with other organizations of mutual concern

Program Committee

Draws in members to the division and arranges ASC events specific to the purposes and objectives of the division

Special Events Committee

Arranges special events of interest to the membership of the division

Student Affairs Committee

Draws more students to the division and to the broader focus of the division (doing research on corrections and sentencing)

Website

Maintains and updates the division website
